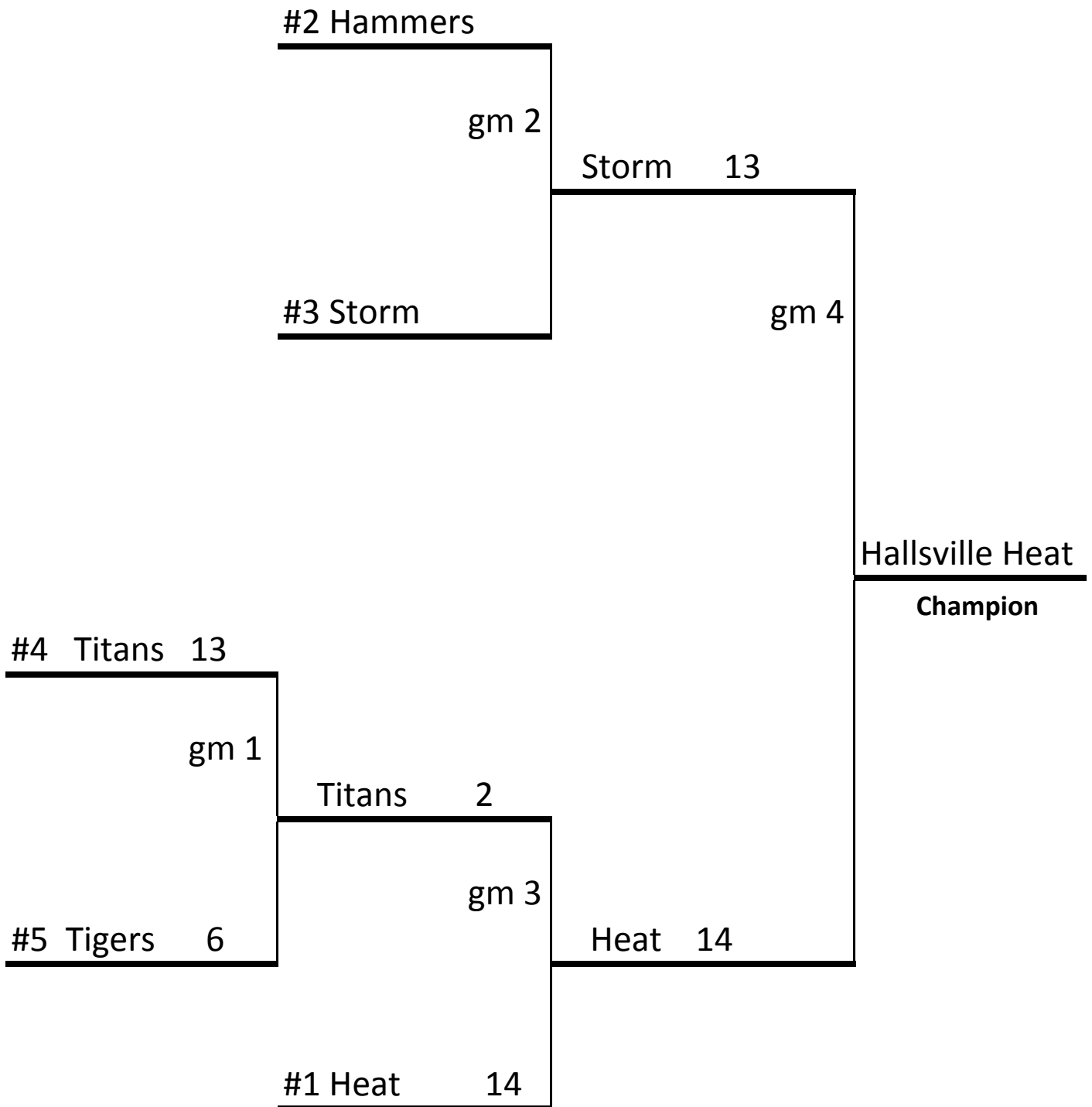


13/14U Columbia Kickoff Sunday Single Elimination Bracket



Tourney Rules

USSSA State Qualifier

Tournament Format: 2 Pool Games seeded into Single Elimination Bracket play

Coaches - Here is your checklist of things to do:

1) Coaches check in at Registration table 1-hour before your 1st game at the Concession stand where you game will be.

2) You will need the following

- a) a copy of your USSSA Team Roster
- b) Copies of Birth Certificates must be kept with the Coach/Manager in case of a challenge
- c) Proof of Team Insurance

3) Teams will provide game balls that meet USSSA specifications

Deliver two game balls acceptable to the umpire at the coin flip of each game. Teams will be responsible to retrieve foul ball (you do not have to provide a new ball each game). Umpires will return game balls after the game.

4) In case of rain, call 573-874-7663

TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

1) USSSA rules will govern the tournament with the exceptions:

- a) Time Limit: 9/10U 90 Minutes; 11/12U 90 Minutes; 13/14U 1 hr 45 Min
- b) Pool Games may end in a tie; All Bracket Games will be played out to a winner.
- c) A coin flip will determine the HOME team. Game time begins at the time of the coin flip.
- d) 10U teams may bat their roster during Saturday games.

2) Head Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their players, coaches, parents and fans.

3) Team chants and chatter may only be directed at your own team.

Phrases such as "swing batter", "Hit It to Me", or "Strike Out Batter", will not be allowed.

4) Absolutely No infield practice on playing fields. You may give ground balls behind the bases near the outfield.

5) Pitchers and catchers must warm up in FOUL territory

6) The official score keeper will be the scorekeeper of the home team.

The umpires will report the scores to the tournament director, however, both teams are responsible for checking the results, which will be posted at the tourney headquarters.

7) Teams are will be seeded into Single Elimination Brackets based on the results of Pool Game Play.

10U Teams - Saturday games will be Tune up games. Sunday game will count as Bracket game.

8) It is the responsibility of the Coach to obtain their bracket game time

9) No protest on judgment calls, only rule interpretation

10) In case of rain it is the responsibility of the coaches to obtain their game times for the modified rain schedule.

4.10.E Coin Flip
